
OLD GOLD CARDS (PRE-FEBRUARY 2014) - no longer reissueing

The TSHA Operator Training Program or "Gold Card" was created as the result of the TSHA working with industry, helping them to comply with the WHS/OHS Acts and Regulation. The TSHA Gold Card program was designed to ensure that the TSHA Gold Card holder is trained in the safe use and operation of Telescopic Handlers.

The overall intention of the Gold Card Program is to assist operators, employers, equipment owners and manufacturers to more easily be able to comply with the WHS/OHS Regulation.

Current WHS/OHS Regulations require that operators of plant equipment must undergo activity-based instruction and training. As a result, **as of January 2024 old TSHA Gold Cards will not be replaced / reissued by the TSHA**, and the TSHA encourages holders of these old cards to update their Gold Card and receive current Telescopic Handler Operator Training.

OLD AND NEW GOLD CARD TRAINING PROGRAMS





OLD CARD TRAINING PROGRAM: November 2009 - 31 January 2014

The old Gold Card program was originally designed as Duty of Care training and was a toolbox style delivery.

The content was driven by industry needs; and assisted in meeting duty of care requirements under the OHS/WHS Acts and Regulations in place during that period.

NEW GOLD CARD INDUSTRY TRAINING PROGRAM: since 1 February 2014

The introduction of the new course included the following changes:

- Additional content on risk management.
- Newly designed learning and assessment resources, mapped to a Unit of Competency from the Resources and Infrastructure (RII) Training Package.
- A change from Duty of Care style delivery to Competency-Based training and assessment.
- Modular style training allowing future addition of different attachment combination competencies in a short format.
- The new training program now has a pathway to a Statement of Attainment.

- Photo card and the specific make and model of Telehandler and attachment type used in training and assessment is recorded.
- A 5 year expiry date on the card which requires the holder to undergo online or face to face refresher training to ensure their skills and knowledge remain current.
- Ability to check the validity of a card via a QR Code or online using the TSHA website.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Can I just change my old Gold Card to the new one?

A. There is no provision for holders of an old Gold Card to upgrade to the new Gold Card without attending the new training course. The old Gold Card content does not directly map to the new program.

Q. I have lost my old card, can I get a replacement Gold Card?

A. The TSHA are not replacing Gold Cards received from training delivered prior to February 2014. Since this time the Gold Card Training has been significantly updated.

The TSHA recommend that everyone updated their TSHA Gold Card and received current Telescopic Handler Operator Training.

Q. Can I keep using my old Gold Card? Is the old card not acceptable?

A. TSHA recommend that operators with the old style Gold Card update their skills by undertaking face to face training. You may find many sites will no longer accept the old style card and site specific rules must be complied with.

This can be done by finding an Accredited Trainer on the TSHA website and attending the 1-day training course. We will still keep records of the old card to demonstrate that you were trained under the old Program. You can still validate your training on our website: www.tsha.com.au

Q. Is this change, just to ensure all cards include a photo?

A. No it is not about the photo ID. The TSHA Gold Card Training course has been significantly updated and this change has been made to ensure all Gold Cards currently being issued meet current WHS Regulations.

Q. What if you change the course again? Will I need to get training every time you make a change?

No. With the updated icourse, we also introduced an online renewal course. This is an effective way to keep operators up-to-date with safe work practices.

We regularly update and improve the TSHA Gold Card Training Program, including the online renewal course.

Please ensure you keep your details (email and phone number) that the TSHA hold up to date and you will be notified when your card is due to expire and provided with details on how to renew.

Q. I have regularly operated Telescopic Handlers and have kept my practical skills current. Why do I need new training?

TSHA Gold Card Training is based on assessing the operator's competency in safely operating a Telescopic Handler. It includes a classroom component as well as practical assessment. The training includes many safety messages that may help operators avoid taking risks when operating telehandlers.

If you have been regularly using a Telescopic Handler then you should have no concerns with the training and you may find some helpful lessons to keep you and others safe.
